First children have gene therapy treatment for blindness at GOSH. The first paediatric patients have received a pioneering new gene therapy that can restore eyesight at Great Ormond Street Hospital. Babies born with an inherited retinal disorder, known as Leber's Congenital Amaurosis (LCA), have poor sight which swiftly deteriorates, with many ultimately losing their vision completely in childhood.

Play therapy is very effective for children aged 3 to 12. The child chooses from a range of activities in the play room. These include: drawing and painting, sand tray, clay, puppets, musical instruments, story-telling, role play. The Play Therapist focuses closely on the child, communicating using the media the child has chosen.
